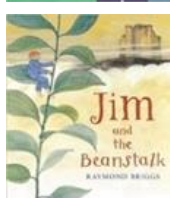
## 'Puddings to Pepys'

In Geography, we will be exploring comparisons between the capital cities of the United Kingdom and Bexhill. In science, we will be learning about everyday materials. We will look at different materials and think about how they are similar and different. We will do some investigations to find out what materials are best for making a boat float. In RE, we will make connections between Muslim beliefs and their way of living. In PE, we will be learning how to play invasion games, participating in team games, engaging in competitive, co-operative physical activities. In Art, the children will be exploring colour and tone, whilst looking at the artists Jan Griffier & JWM Turner.



## English

This term we will be reading both 'A Walk in London' by Salvatore Rubbino and 'Jim and the Beanstalk' by Raymond Briggs. We will be working towards writing our own walk-in guidebook and a sequel story.



## Daily Supported Reader

Daily Supported Reader is reading programme in which children learn to read independently at the level that they are working on. This term, we will be learning how to problem solve when we are stuck on words.



## Maths

Using our maths mastery approach, we will be learning about place value. We will be exploring place value of each number in a two-digit number. We will be building the children's strategies of counting in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's.

This term we are exploring what makes a good friend. We will be learning how to develop strategies and behaviours surrounding friendships.
